

When applying for a Supervisor certificate please ensure that you include with your application:

1. Proof of completion of a supervisor course delivered by a course provider who is accredited to the DCBC.
2. Copy of your current medical
3. Copies of your first aid, CPR/AED and O₂ Provider courses.
4. A passport style photo
5. Proof of the various requirements listed below:

For SCUBA Supervisor

- a. a minimum of one year's experience and a minimum of 50 dives logged as a diver in the category being supervised;
- b. supervision of a minimum of 16 dives of the appropriate category
- c. supervision of a minimum of four mock incidents involving decompression sickness, burst lung syndrome, lost diver, and trapped diver. These incidents shall be logged (documented).

For Restricted Surface Supplied Supervisor

- a. a minimum of two years' experience and a minimum of 75 dives logged as a restricted surface-supplied diver;
- b. supervision of a minimum of 25 dives; and
- c. while acting as a trainee supervisor and under the direct observation of a qualified restricted surface-supplied supervisor, supervision of a minimum of three mock incidents involving decompression sickness, burst lung syndrome, and trapped diver. These incidents shall be logged (documented).

For Unrestricted Surface Supplied Supervisor

- a. a minimum of three years' experience and a minimum of 200 dives logged as an unrestricted surface-supplied diver;
- b. supervision of a minimum of 25 surface-supplied dives
- c. while acting as a trainee supervisor and under the direct observation of a qualified unrestricted surface-supplied supervisor, supervision of a minimum of three mock incidents involving decompression sickness, burst lung syndrome, and trapped diver. These incidents shall be logged (documented).
